



#11) HELMET KNIT in RIB w/OPEN FACE
using **double pointed** needles

2 skein acrylic worsted weight yarn.

Colors: please consult the color page chart.

2 pairs # 5, 10" long double-pointed knitting needles

Cast on 96 sts, place them on 3 needles, join and work in ribbing of K2, P2 for 6", ending last round with K2.

FACE-OPENING-- Bind off the first 22sts, work in ribbing to end of round. Work back and forth in ribbing on remaining 74sts, for 18 rows.

Cast on 22sts for upper edge of face-opening, work round in all 96sts for 3"; decrease 1 st at end of last round.

2nd round, and every other round thereafter: knit all sts.

3rd round: * k 16, k 2 tog, repeat from * to end of round.

4th round: even.

5th round: * k 15, k 2 tog, repeat from * to end of round.

TOP OF HELMET: Work in st st, shaping it as follows * K 17, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round (5 decreases).

Continue in this way to work one st less between dec, in each successive dec round, until 45sts remain, then dec in every round until 15sts remain.

Break off yarn, draw through all 15sts twice, tighten and weave in ends on wrong side.

Cut yarn leaving enough to weave the back seam. Thread tapestry needle and pass through last 6 sts 2 times and pull tight.

Before you attach the logo tag PLEASE write a short note to the service person, with your name & address on back. Using tapestry needle, **secure the card INSIDE up in the crown to insure it's not torn off.**
